Privacy Policy

In line with government regulations regarding GDPR, below is IACCCA's privacy policy which outlines how we collect, store and process your data. If you have any questions, please contact us at contact@iaccca.com.

This policy applies to information on members and prospective members, suppliers and prospective suppliers, curators, contacts and all other persons about whom IACCCA holds information. By 'information', we mean personal information about you that we collect, use, share and store. In this policy, "we," "us," and "our" means IACCCA, a non profit association registered in Switzerland with N° 080.502.128, and "you" means the individual to whom the information relates.

What we collect

- your name;
- your contact information such as your address, email address and telephone number;
- information related to your attendance of, and interest in, our events;
- information about you that you give us in person or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or
- otherwise; and
- information concerning your membership, application of membership or use of our services.

How we collect information about you

- the information you provide to us when you apply for a membership or visit us at each event;
- the information you provide when you contact us by phone, email or post
- the information you provide when handing your business card
- the information you provide when making an enquiry through our website

What we do with the information we gather

We use your information to:

- provide information about our services to you;
- keep you informed about our news and events that we think you may find interesting;
- carry out our obligations arising from any agreements entered into between you and us;
- communicate with you;
- administer our site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes;
- keep our site safe and secure;
- comply with legal and regulatory obligations;
- for security and to check your identity.

Legitimate interests

Where our processing is based on the legitimate interest grounds described above, those legitimate interests are:

• to make sure you receive updated information on IACCCA's activities (exhibitions, new publications, news, events ...);

to provide requested services;

Legal basis for processing

Our processing of your personal information is necessary:

- for the performance of contracts to which you will be a party to and to take steps at your request before you enter into those contracts;
- for legitimate interests pursued by us; or
- to comply with a legal obligation to which we are subject; about any processing of special categories of personal data, we will rely on obtaining specific consent from you at the time unless there is otherwise a legal requirement for us to process such information.

Sharing your information

We will not sell, distribute or lease your personal information to third parties unless we have your permission or are required by law to do so.

We may also share your personal information with:

- law enforcement agencies, other governmental agencies or third parties if we are required by law to do so; and
- selected services in relation to a purchase, such as art shippers and couriers, who will need an address for delivery MailChimp is our GDPR-compliant marketing automation platform and only has access to email addresses and no other data, you can see their Privacy Statement Policy here.

Your Rights

At any time, you have the right:

- to request access to or a copy of any personal data which we hold about you;
- to rectification of your personal data, if you consider that the information we are holding is inaccurate;
- to ask us to delete your personal data, if you consider that we do not have the right to hold it;
- to withdraw consent to our processing of your personal data (to the extent such processing is based on previously obtained consent);
- to ask us to stop or start sending you marketing messages as described below in the marketing section;
- to restrict processing of your personal data;
- to data portability (moving some of your personal data elsewhere) in certain circumstances;
- to object to your personal data being processed in certain circumstances; and
- to not be subject to a decision based on automated processing and to have safeguards put in place if you are being profiled based on your personal data.
- Any request from you for access to or a copy of your personal data must be in writing, and we will endeavour to respond within a reasonable period and in any event within one month in compliance with data protection legislation. We will comply with our legal obligations as regards your rights as a data subject.

How long will we keep your information?

We will only keep the information we collect about you for as long as required for the purposes set out above or as required to comply with any legal obligations to which we are subject. This will involve us periodically reviewing our files to check that information is accurate, up-to-date and still required. Some of the legal requirements to keep your data will be, for instance, dictated by the HMRC requirement to keep a record of all transactions for six years. Where we are permitted to send you direct exhibition information, new publications and/or news, we may retain your contact information necessary for this purpose, for as long as you do not unsubscribe. If you opt out of our emails, we will retain your information to enable us to respect your wishes to not be contacted for marketing purposes.

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.
